Methodology

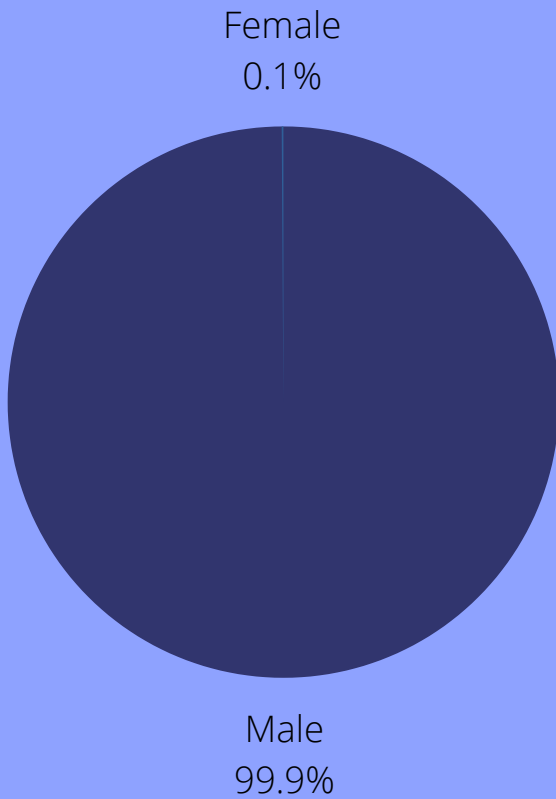
- Quantitative Research

Limitations

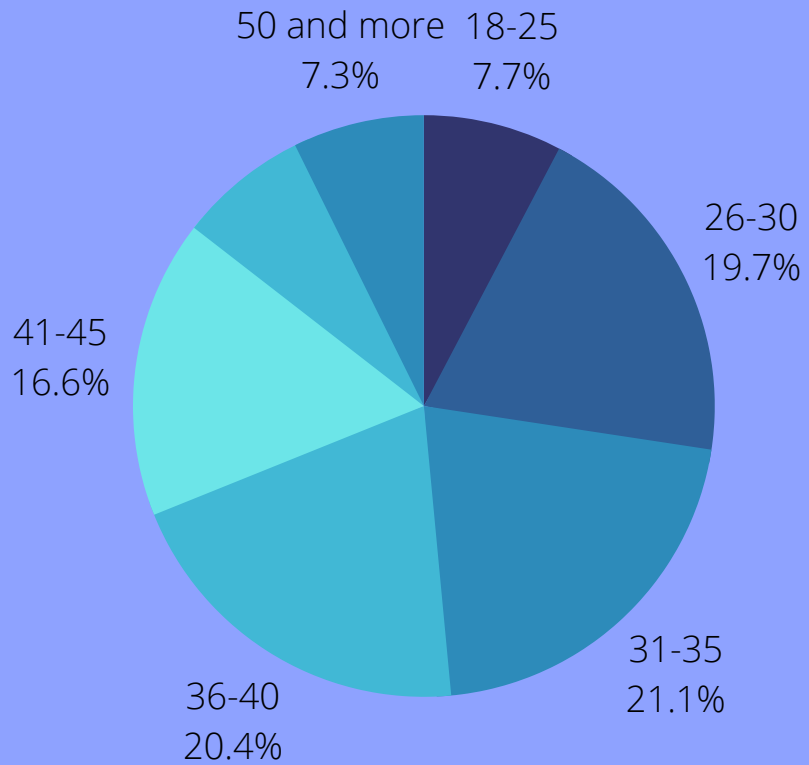
- Respondents might've selected the options without reading.

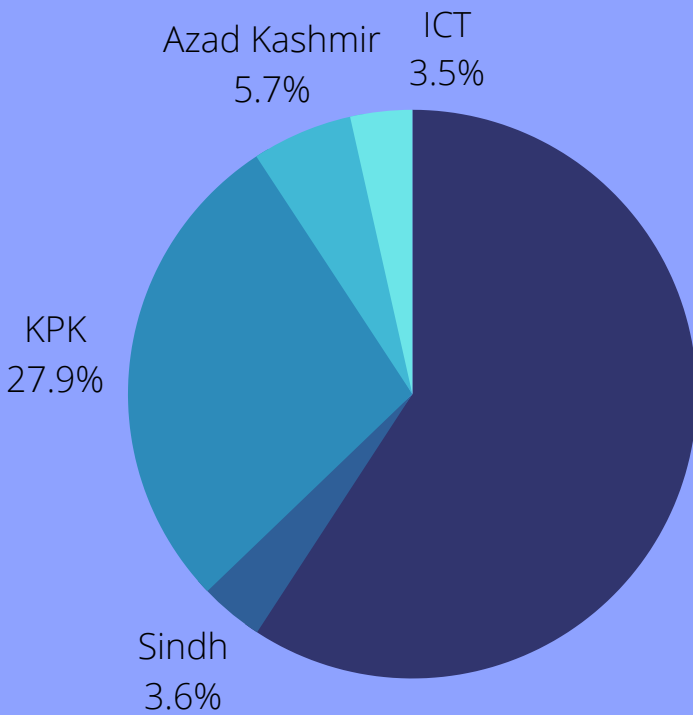

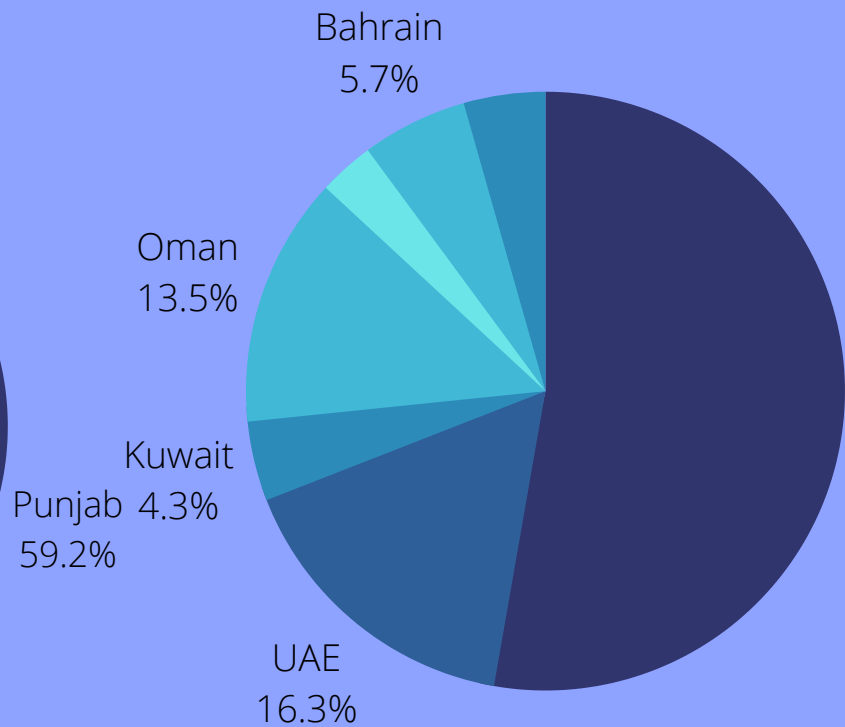
Gender

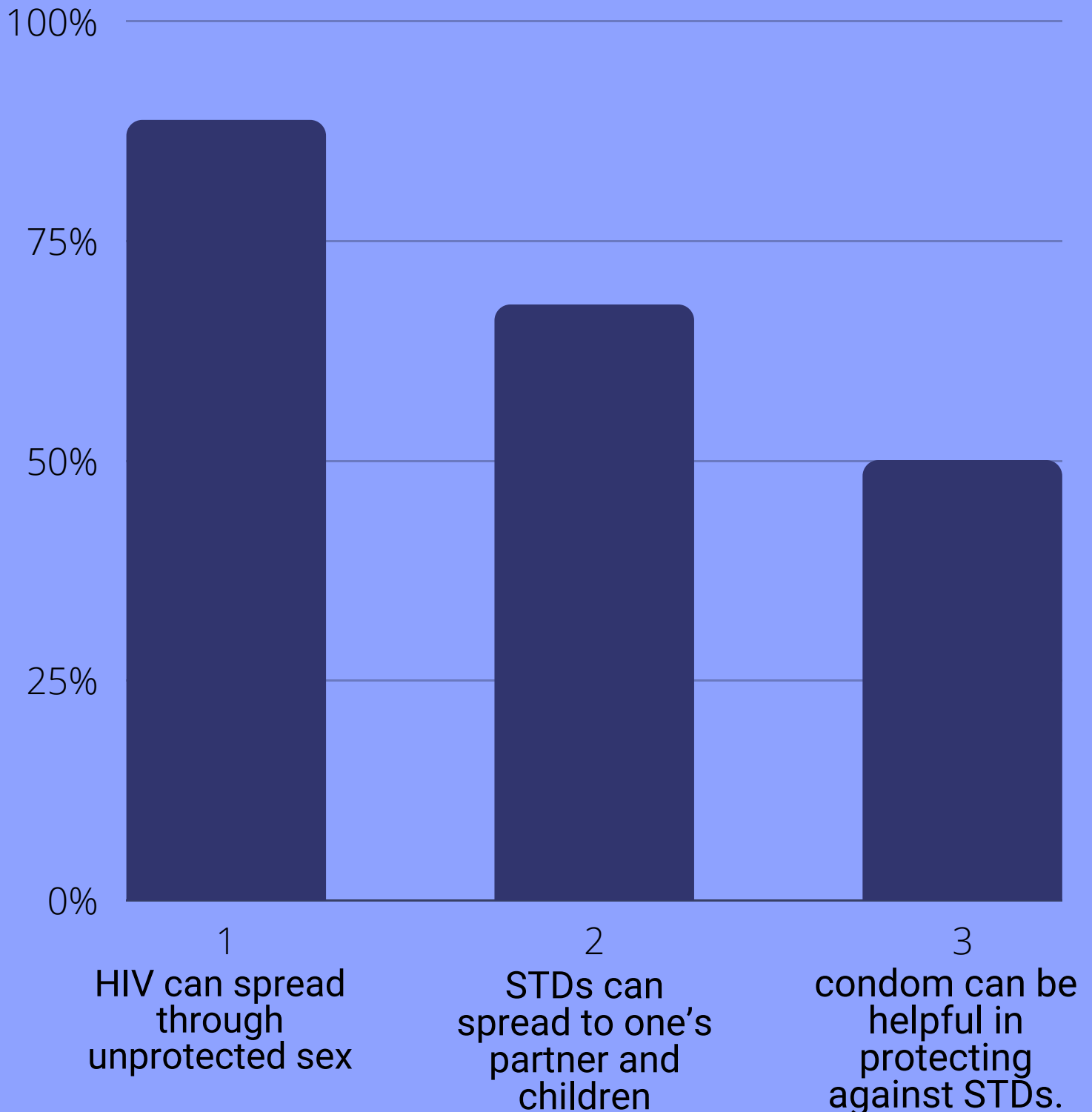

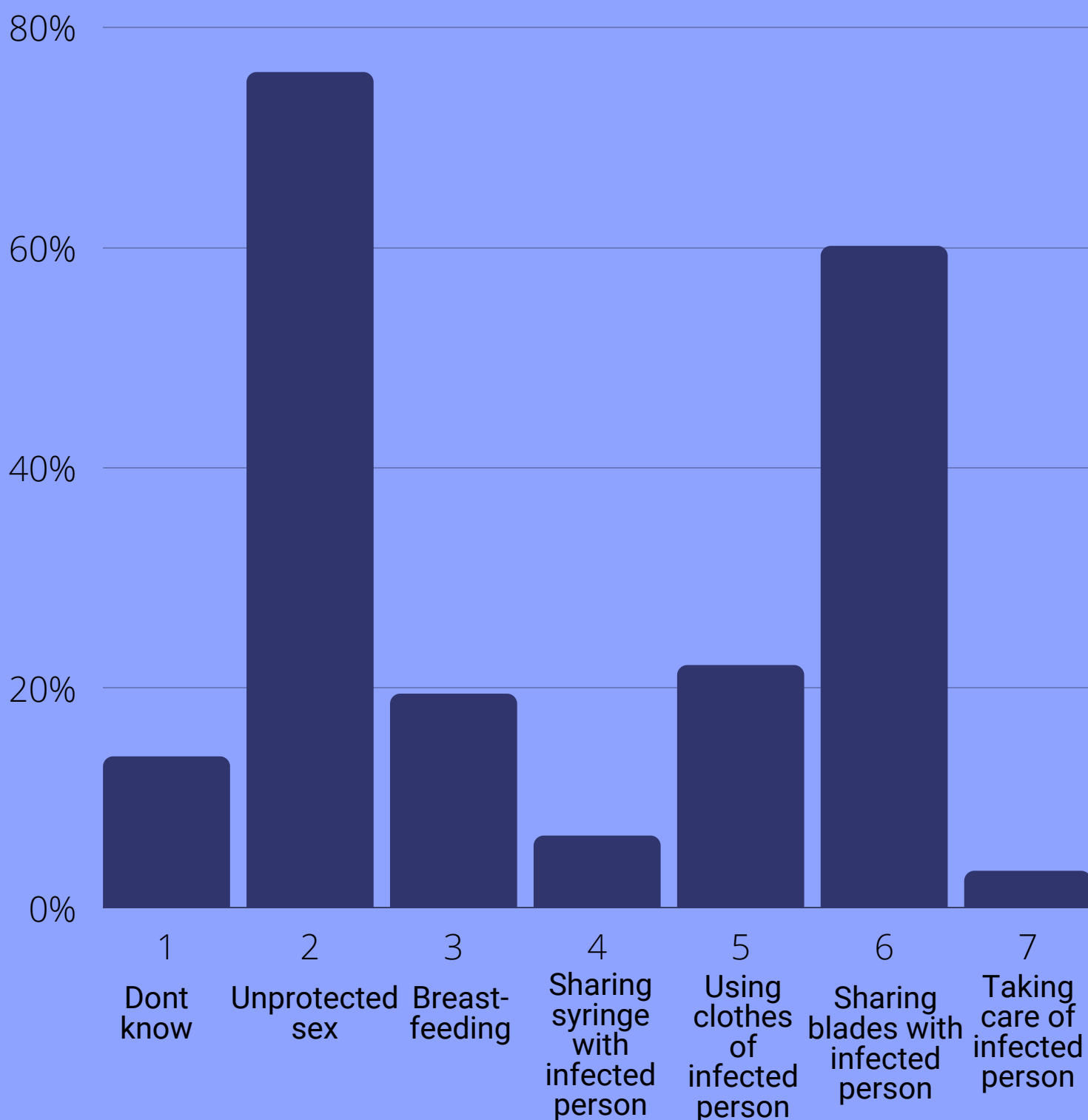
Respondents (migrants) awareness regarding the spread of HIV

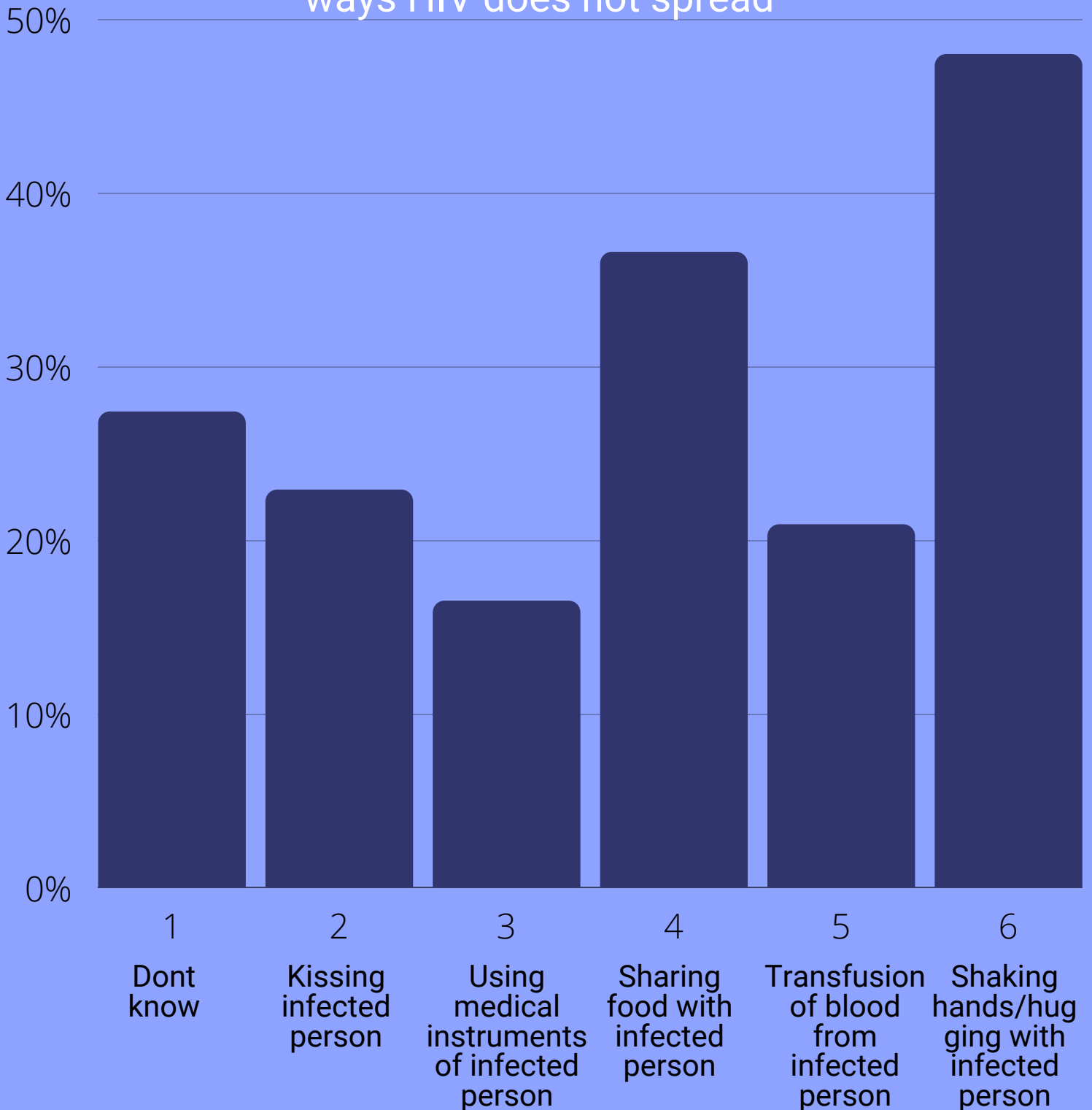
Respondents (migrants) knowledge regarding the ways of transmission of HIV

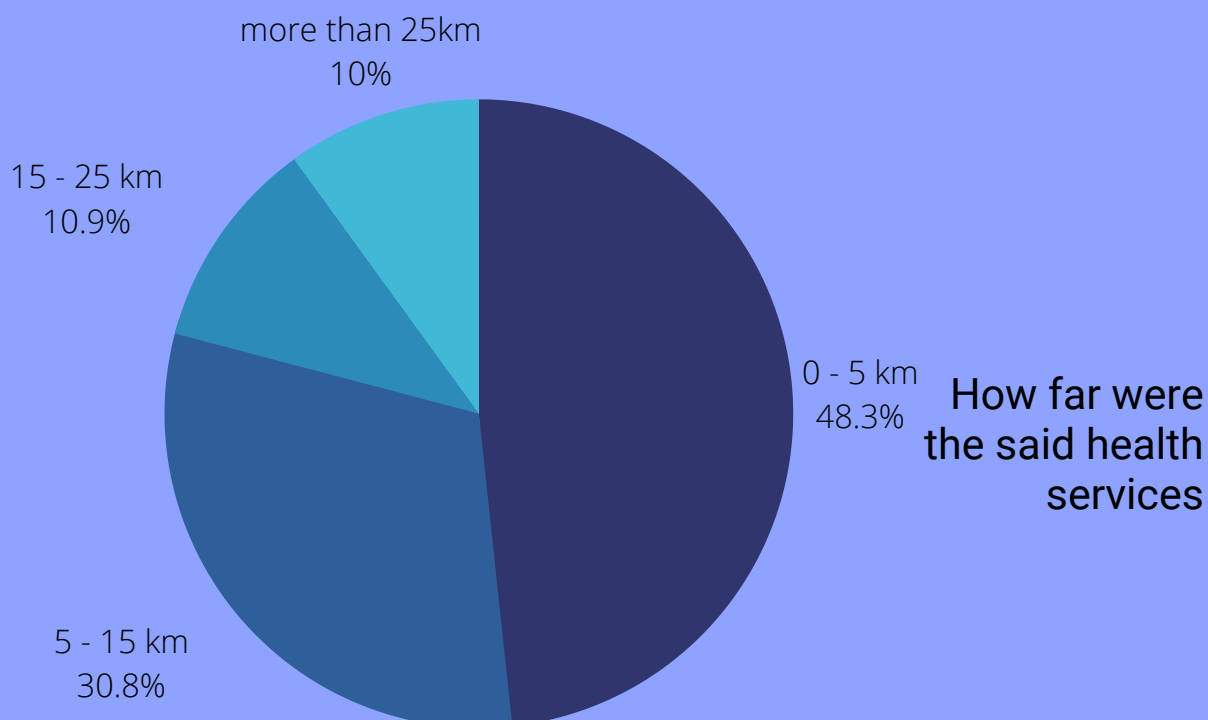
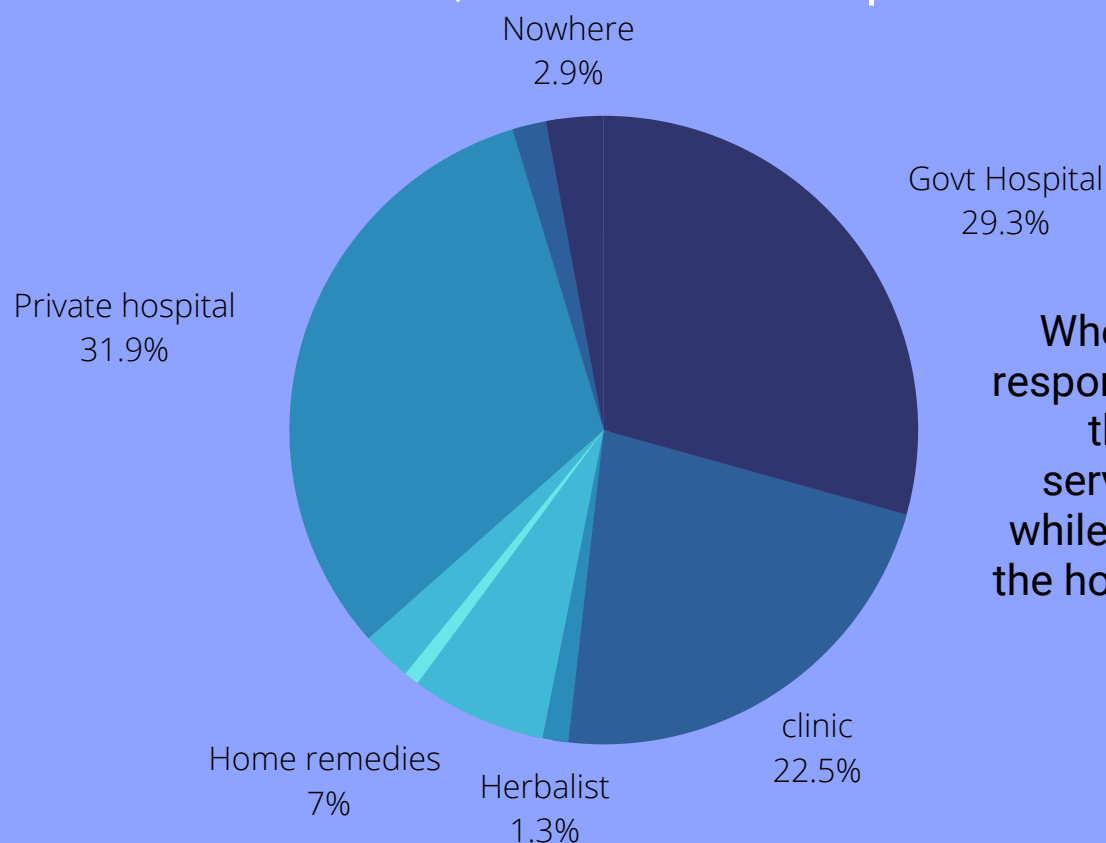
Respondents (migrants) knowledge regarding the ways HIV does not spread





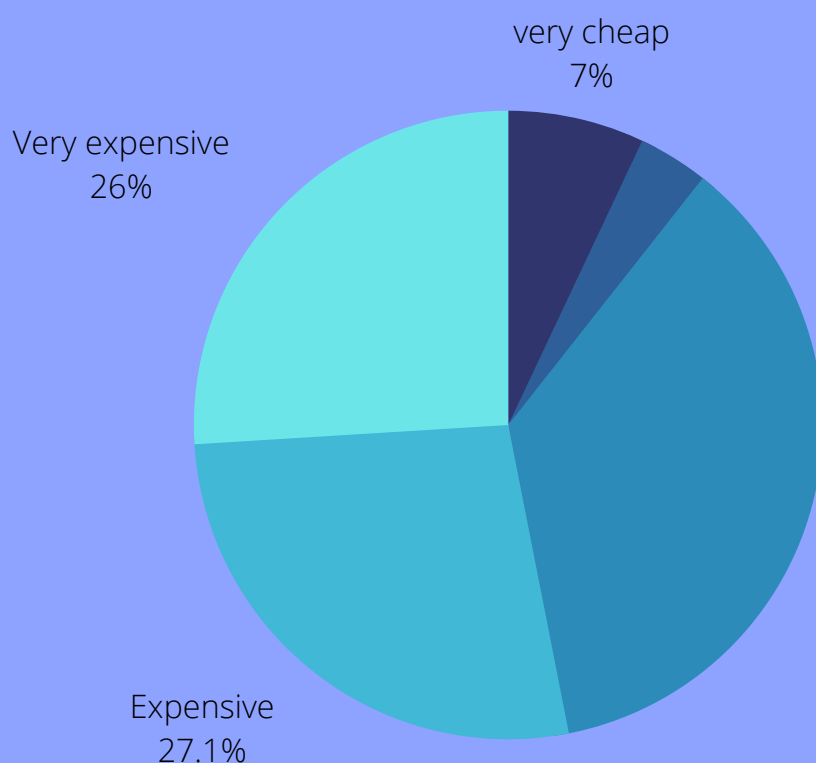

Health facilities abroad, available for respondents (migrants)



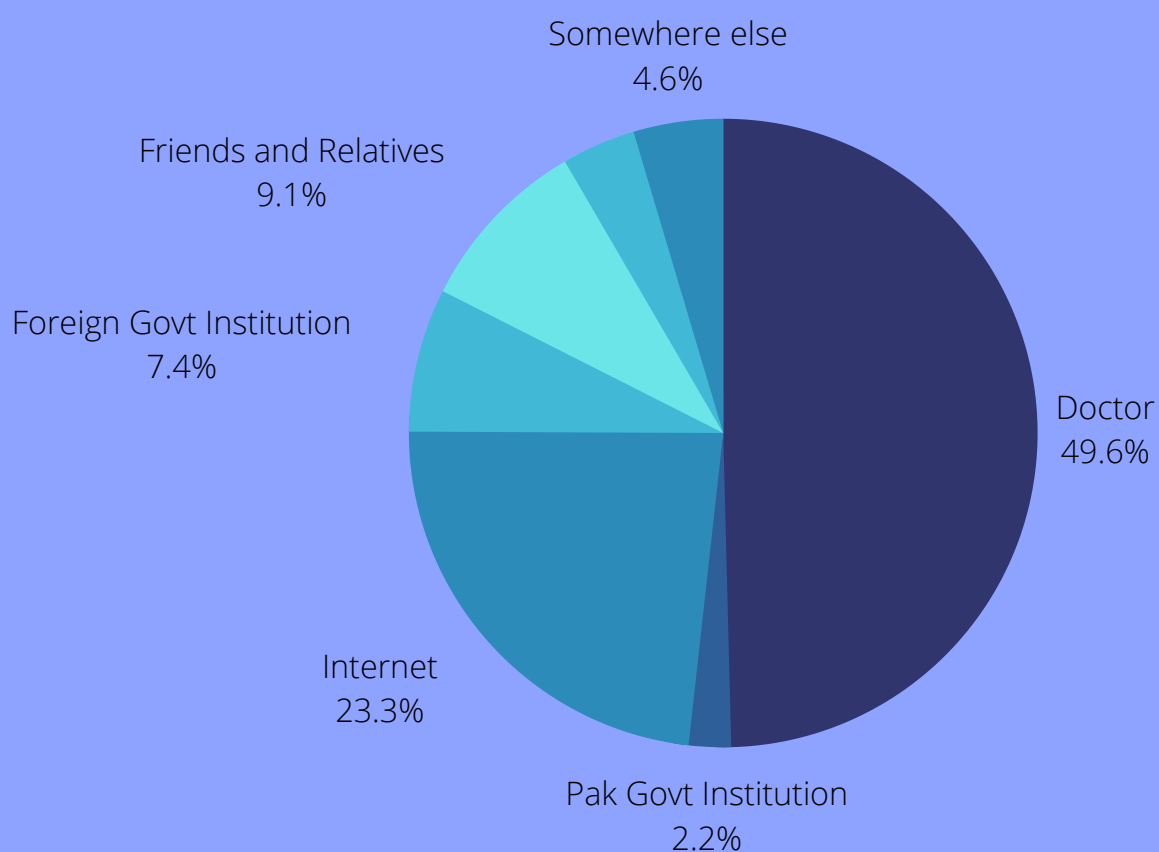
